FACILITY: 6 lane, 25 yard pool with a depth of 12 feet at the starting blocks. Electronic Timing (buttons). Ample deck space for swimmers and spectator seating for 300.

ELIGIBILITY: Swimmers must be 2006 or 2007 registered members of USA Swimming. All coaches must present a valid USA Swimming Coach Card to the Meet Director prior to the commencement of any sanctioned swim meet, and must have this card with them while on deck

FEES: \$4.00 per individual event; \$8.00 per relay event. Please make all checks payable to Woodbridge Aquatic Club.

ENTRIES: Swimmers may enter and compete in four individual events. If a session is over-subscribed, 7/U will be scratched, then relays will be eliminated, then swimmers will be limited to three events. (Swimmers entered in four events must circle the event from which they wish to be scratched.) If the meet remains oversubscribed, further cuts will be made based on the order in which entries are received. Connecticut teams whose entries are received by October 24 will receive priority before out of state entries are accepted. **All entries must be received by Wednesday, October 25, 2006.**

Teams are encouraged to submit their entry via e-mail or disk (either LSA SwimTeam or Hy-tek). **Any team entering more than 5 swimmers that fails to submit an electronic entry will pay a surcharge of \$3 per swimmer.** Please be sure to include a paper printout with your e-mail/disk, or use a CSI entry form. Mark unattached swimmers in RED on the entry form. Be sure to include the phone number of a club official and a mailing address for results. If you use overnight mail or Federal Express, please waive signature for delivery.

Entry fees must be mailed to the above address, postmarked no later than Wednesday October 25.

The meet referee reserves the right to make any adjustments to the provisions of the Meet announcement deemed necessary to ensure the fair and efficient running of the meet, with prior approval from Program Operations.

The 12/Under sessions will be limited to four hours of competition. Teams will be notified of any changes affecting their swimmers as soon as possible and no later than Friday, October 27.

Connecticut Swimming guidelines will be observed at all sessions.

AWARDS: Ribbons will be presented through sixth place in each of the following age groups for individual events: 10 & Under, 11/12, 13/14, and 15/O. Ribbons will be presented through third place for relay events.

REFRESHMENTS: Food and beverages will sold throughout the meet. A hospitality room for officials and coaches will be available throughout the day. An ample lunch for officials and coaches will be available between sessions.

DIRECTIONS:

From the east or west: I-95 to to I-91 North. Take Exit 3 (Trumbull Street). Go straight ahead on Trumbull to Prospect Street. Turn right and follow Prospect Street about 1 ¼ mile to Huntington Street. Turn left onto Huntington Street and the Athletic Center is just ahead on the left.

From the north: Follow the Wilbur Cross Parkway (Route 15) to Exit 61 (Whitney Ave.) Turn right and follow Whitney Ave. about 4 miles to Ogden Street. Turn right onto Ogden and proceed to

Prospect Street. Turn left onto Prospect Street and take a right onto Huntington Street. The Athletic Center is just ahead on the right.

Handicapped/Elderly Accessibility: Handicapped parking and ramped access to the pool are located at the main lobby entrance of the facility. An area has been set aside on the pool deck for limited handicapped seating. Handicapped bathrooms are available in both the men and women locker rooms.
